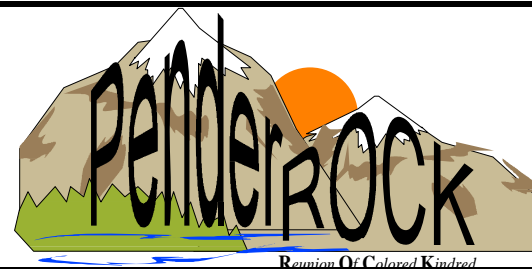

The website is almost complete. The design is by Tyrone Goodwyn. The actual development work was performed by Tyrone and two separate web developers that he hired using his own funds. No family reunion funds went into the development of the website.

The concept of the site is that of a home. There are pages 'in the yard' that contain public information for anyone. Personal family info is inside the house. It is accessed by a 'key' (username & password). This prevents strangers from seeing our private info. PenderROCK secretary will assign usernames only to persons that are recognized. Please do not share your username – protect your 'home'.

There are *not* a lot of instructions on the site. It is graphical instead of textual. Move your mouse over various objects. If they highlight, then <click>. The data is behind the pictures. For example, if you <click> on the picture of the family history book, you will open a page that has the book's contents. The small arrows give you clues on how to move from room to room. And of course, clicking on doors and doorways will move you also.

This newsletter and past newsletters are posted on the refrigerator in the kitchen, which is the room past the stairway, down the hall to the left.
