




What happened to love Grove School Project?

In 2004 you voted to turn the scholarship funds into a new separate tax-exempt organization whose mission is to procure and renovate the pre-1900 schoolhouse that our ancestors attended.

Status: We are slowly working our way through the paperwork to establish the non-profit tax-exempt organization to hold the funds. New Hope Baptist Church agreed to let the school sit on their property. They prefer the uncleared lot next door to the church. We need to do a title search in Pender County Register of Deeds office to ensure that this is New Hope's land.

To date all of the scholarship money and subsequent donations are still in the PenderROCK account. \$0.00 has been spent.

PenderROCK consists mainly of the surnames listed above. We took the name 'PenderROCK' in 1997, after we had merged so many family reunions that the name became too long to say.

Pender is the county where we originated.well not exactly! Wests, Merritts, and Williams are originally from Sampson County. Our immediate ancestors migrated to Pender in 1870s/1880s.

Our West/Merritt/Williams/Mainor kin in Sampson have approached us about the possibility of combined reunions. But the name 'Pender' ROCK excludes them – unless they know the history of the two county's people. And most don't. *You don't*!

At the 2005 reunion, we will discuss possible names for a combined reunion.

The name needs to have meaning for both Pender and Sampson people.

The name can't be so general that ANYbody could think it is their reunion.

The name needs to include 'PenderROCK' because we have a lot of goodwill and reputation associated with that name that we don't want to lose.

The name needs to be easy to say and remember.

The board will bring suggestions to the 2005 meeting for the general body's vote.
